WHAT TO BRING THE DAY OF THE CLINIC

- Your washed goat (Need a goat? See below)
- CVI Paperwork & Self Inspection
- Holding pen (Need a pen? See below. Very limited availability)
- Water bucket & hay for your goat
- Goat stand
- Clippers, clipper oil & #10 clipping blade
- Clipper cooling & cleaning spray
- 5' x 8' Tarp or larger
- Extension cord
- Broom/shovel for clean-up
- Baby wipes
- Show collar
- Hoof brush
- Your lunch & water
- Hat & sunscreen (we will be outside, if weather allows)

SKILL LEVEL TRACK OVERVIEWS

1. Intro to Fitting & Showing

i Who should take this skill level track? Interested in showing goats, 1st year – 2nd year showman or you feel you have no idea what you are doing.

These workshops will cover the basics of clipping a dairy goat from head to tail, clipper care, showing in the ring and judging skill-a-thon skills. Bring a washed unclipped goat for this workshop.

2. Fitting & Showing 101

i Who should take this skill level track? You have been showing for a couple of years now, but still end up in the bottom half of the showmanship class.

These workshops will help you work on the skills needed to bring your showmanship up to the next level in clipping, maneuvers and judging skill-a-thon. Bring a goat you have clipped within a week prior to this event.

3. Advanced Fitting & Showing

i *Who should take this skill level track? You have been showing dairy goats for several years now and are in 2nd or 3^d place in the showmanship class, but just cannot seem to get Grand Champion Showman.*

These workshops will help you master the skills needed to bring your showmanship up to the next level in clipping, maneuvers and judging skill-a-thon. Bring a goat you have clipped within a week prior to this event.

EVENT PREPARATION

i *Wash your goat the day before the event.*

If you are in the Fitting & Showing 101 or Advanced Fitting & Showing workshops you will want to clip your goat within a week prior the event. Just like you would for a show.

NEED A GOAT?

i *We have several 4-Her's with goats they can loan for the day. Just click yes on the registration form when asked, "Do you need to borrow a goat?".*

NEED A PEN?

i *Hereford Junior Farm Fair has graciously given us use of their pens. A pen will need to be reserved in advance, as they will need to be set up prior to our event. A donation of \$5-10 would be appreciated. Donations can be paid during registration. Just click yes on the registration form when asked, "Do you need a pen for your goat?".*
