1. These shows are sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and its rules shall govern. There will be two Combined Doe Shows and two Junior Doe Shows. They are sanctioned for the following breeds: COMBINED DOE SHOWS: Alpines, LaManchas, Nigerians, Nubians, Oberhasli, Saanens, Toggenburgs and Recorded Grades; JUNIOR DOE SHOWS: Alpines, LaManchas, Nigerians, Nubians, Oberhasli, Saanens, Toggenburgs and Recorded Grades. The Combined Shows and Junior Shows are separately sanctioned. Show order is subject to change only in case of any emergency determined by the show committee.
2. The base date for computing the age of the doe entered is May 30, 2020.
3. Health Regulations: All out-of-state exhibitors must have a health certificate signed by a veterinarian within 30 days of the show. WV herds: either an honor herd certificate or CVI. All animals will be checked for contagious disease (sore mouth, pink-eye, ring worm, open abscess, etc) by either the WV Dept. of Agriculture or the show committee. Any herds exhibiting signs will not be allowed to show. The decision of the show committee is final.
4. The original registration is required for all animals. A stamped duplicate (good for 30 days from date of issue) will be accepted for all animals under six months of age.
5. Check-in will begin no later than 7:00 AM on Saturday. Animals must be on the grounds by 8:00 AM. Showmanship classes will begin at 8:00 AM sharp with prizes awarded to winners. \$25 is being donated to the first place adult showmanship winner (must be at least two entries). Breed classes will begin at 9:00 AM with the combined shows in both rings followed by the raffle and then junior does. Arrival on Friday, May 29 will be allowed after 6 PM.
6. Early entry fee is \$6 per head per ring postmarked or entered online on or before Saturday, May 16. Late entry fee is \$10 per animal per ring and must be RECEIVED BY or entered online by Wednesday, May 27. Entries received after that date or day-of-show are \$15 per head per ring. Substitutions will be allowed within the breed in the same show only. Entries may be entered online or emailed to Shenandoahdairygoat@gmail.com. Mail entry fee checks made out to MDGA and any paper entries to Kim Toombs 3138 Basford Rd. Frederick, MD 21703. **WE WILL BE USING THE HOG BARN FOR PENNING.** Your names will be on your assigned pens. Pens are 4'x6'. We will try to have a buffer pen between some herds, so please order any additional tack pens you may need. Please note, this year **you must clean your own pens** or make arrangements with any youth available at the show. We will try to have a list of youth who will take donations to clean out your pens for you at the check in table. Thank you!

7. The fairgrounds' charge for any other barn usage is \$150. Early and regular entry fee for tack or animal pens is \$5 per pen. Day-of -show pens are \$8 each and may not be available so please plan in advance. Straw is not provided. If you are showing any animals from out of your trailer or truck, there is a \$10 fee. Trailer areas **MUST BE CLEANED** before leaving.
8. All Best of Breed winners must be present for the Best Doe in Show class.
9. MDGA, SDGA, ADGA, and the Jefferson County Fairgrounds will not be responsible for loss, damage, or accident to any person or property. Show entry indicates acceptance of all conditions in this form.
10. Dogs are not permitted in the barns or in the show ring area.
11. There will be a \$35 bank fee charged for any returned checks.
12. Show books may be left near the secretaries' tables as a convenience to the exhibitors during *the show*.
13. *There will be NO food booth this year.*

RAFFLE: Our regular big raffle will be held between the Combined Doe and Junior Doe Shows. We sincerely appreciate your donations and participation in this fundraiser which keeps this show afloat.

DIRECTIONS: From I-81 North/South take WV exit #12. Follow Rt 45 east which leads into route 9 east (towards Charles Town). Continue on Rt 9 East. Turn left onto Grapevine Road. Turn right onto Golf Course Road and after 1 mile the BERKELEY COUNTY YOUTH FAIRGROUNDS will be on the left.
