Welcome to MDGA's 25th Annual Buck Show.
Important Buck Show Changes & Updates

We will be sanctioning Alpines, LaManchas, Nigerian Dwarfs, Nubians, Toggenburgs, and All Other Purebred (Guernsey, Oberhasli and Sables). We will try to balance out the 3 rings but you should probably expect some down time between the rings since animal numbers may vary from breed to breed and ring to ring. No Challenge Classes will be held for bucks this year.

We will also be featuring the Alpines International Club (AIC) Alpine Buck Specialty for ADGA District III with Judge: Jean Lucas. AIC will be providing special rosettes for the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion buck. Please be sure to get pictures taken of your winning Alpine Specialty bucks!

Exhibitors may find it very helpful to bring tie chains this year. All 3 rings will be in the main show ring and moving animals back and forth from pens may involve going through or around another show ring. Please bring any tie chains that you have.

The MDGA will follow any updated ADGA shows rules including the use of stamped duplicates for any age animal until September 30, 2022.

Guidance to ADGA Show Chairpersons and Secretaries - To be included in Show ROA Packets

The ADGA Board of Directors has approved the use of stamped duplicates of applications for registry to show an animal of any age at all shows through September 30, 2022. This measure is necessary due to the delays in the ADGA computer conversion project. We request all organizations (including state fairs) that hold ADGA sanctioned shows during this time period accept stamped duplicates as well as Certificates of Registry.

Show Chairpersons and Show Secretaries should accept the stamped duplicates in accordance with this temporary ADGA Show rule change. The report of Awards should be completed with the "pending" written in the registration number section if no registration number is shown on the stamped duplicate. All other required information remains the same.

- All 3 buck shows are sanctioned by ADGA for the following breeds: Alpine, Lamancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Toggenburg and All Other Purebred.
- Entries due: **Postmark Saturday, April 30, 2022. Member Entry Fee: \$ 7.00 per Buck/per ring or \$20.00 for all 3 rings. The late fee for late or day of show entries is \$30.00 per buck if postmarked after April 30, 2022 or paid day of show entry.** Non-Member Entry Fee: \$12.00 per buck/per ring or \$35.00 for all 3 rings. The late fee for late or day of shows is \$45.00 per buck if postmarked after April 30, 2022. Entry fee must accompany entry form. There will be no refund of fees for any reason. No faxed entries will be accepted. Cash only day of show. Please note: a \$25.00 service fee is charged for all returned checks. There is a mandatory \$5/pen fee (no straw provided) or \$10/trailer if you are showing out of your trailer. Note there are other events on the fairgrounds and trucks and trailers cannot park in any fire lanes. Pens and all trailer areas must be cleaned out before leaving. Used straw bedding should be left on the loading dock. Shavings are not permitted.

- The base date is May 15, 2022 which is the date the animal is to be judged.
- The original registration certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older and MUST be shown at check-in before the start of the show. The original registration certificate or duplicate application stamped by the ADGA office is required for all animals under six months of age and this MUST be shown to the Show Secretary before the start of the show. A stamped duplicate (good for

30 days from date of issue) will be accepted for all animals under six months of age.

- No copies of the registration certificate or the stamped duplicate application, telegrams, or phone calls will be accepted in lieu of the original certificate.
- You will be unable to check in with the show secretaries until a health check has been completed. Upon completion of the health check, a card will be issued to each exhibitor stating that the health check has been completed. A 2022 MD CVI health certificate must be shown to the show officials at the time of unloading. Interstate health papers are required for all animal outside of MD. The "Livestock Exhibitor's Self Certification of Animal Health" must be filled out by the owner/caretaker prior to loading and must be presented upon request to the designated health committee or MDA Animal Health Official. This form can be found on the MDA website www.mda.state.md.us. Any animal showing signs of infectious or contagious disease, as determined by the show officials and/or check-in vet, will be barred from the show. Tattoos may be checked. The decisions of the show officials are final.
- **Animals must be in place and checked in by 10:30 a.m.** on Sunday and will be released at the conclusion of the show. Judging will begin at 11 am in all 3 rings. Animals may arrive on Friday night after 10 pm, however, no overnight security will be provided.
- Breeds will be assigned to each ring and the judges will rotate rings while the breeds are shown in the same rings. The order of the show is subject to change due to emergency as determined by the Show Committee. The tentative breed ring assignments (subject to change due to breed entry numbers) are Ring 1: Alpines & Nubian Ring 2: Nigerian Dwarf & All Other Purebred Ring 3: LaMancha & Toggenburg. Please bring enough handlers if you will be showing multiple breeds. Judging will continue in all 3 rings until all shows are complete.
- This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and ADGA rules shall govern. Only American Dairy Goat Association, American Goat Society, and Canadian Goat Society registered, recorded, or applied for animals may be shown in an official American Dairy Goat Association show. A reminder: Naturally horned animals may not be shown at ADGA sanctioned shows.
- MDGA, ADGA, and the Howard County Fairgrounds will not be responsible for loss, damage, or accident to any person, animal or property. Show entry indicates acceptance of this condition.

- You should be prepared to provide your own meals and beverages. We will not be taking a lunch break. We will be holding a 50/50 raffle during the show.
- In addition – MDGA will follow the local city, county, state health regulations that are in place at the time of the show.

4. All exhibitors are requested to check and fix all tattoos on all bucks before the show. As a courtesy to other exhibitors, we would request that any exhibitors with animals found with illegible or no tattoos not be shown in subsequent show rings.
