- The Senior/Junior COMBINED Doe shows are sanctioned for the following breeds: Alpine, Lamancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, Recorded Grade and AOP (Toggenburg and Sable). The Junior Doe shows are sanctioned for the following breeds: Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Recorded Grade, and All Other Purebreds (Saanen, Sable, Toggenburg). The Senior/Junior Combined and Junior shows ARE separately sanctioned.
- Early Entry fee per doe per ring is \$6.00 if received on or before Saturday, June 13. Regular Entry Fee is \$12.00 per ring per doe if received between Monday, June 15 and Wednesday, June 24. NO entries will be accepted after Wednesday, June 24. No day of show entries. Substitutions *are* permitted day of show. Entry fees must accompany entry form. There will be no refund of fees for any reason. No faxed entries will be accepted.
- 3. Cattle Barns #2 & #3 located directly across from the show ring will be available for exhibitors to set up their own pens @ \$10.00 trailer charge. Please provide your own panels, tie chains, etc. if you wish to use these barns to house your animals. We are not able to guarantee empty pens between exhibitors in the goat barn. Pen fees are \$5/pen and pens are 6' x 6'. If not purchasing pens, there is a \$10 flat fee for showing out of your trailer/truck or setting up in Barn #2 or 3.

STRAW WILL NOT BE PROVIDED, you will need to bring your own. Exhibitors <u>MUST</u> clean their pens out at the conclusion of the show before leaving. The fairgrounds will charge extra if they need to go back and clean your pens, so please be sure that all manure and used bedding is placed in the roll-off off the dock area for the mushroom people to pick up. For a small fee, youth exhibitors may be available to clean your pens for you should you so choose.

- 4. NO SHAVINGS. <u>Absolutely no shavings!</u> There can be no shavings or trash in the used bedding pile that the mushroom people pick up.
- 5. Please check chart onsite for pen assignments.

- 7. The base date is 6/27/20, which is the date the animal is to be judged.
- 8. The original registration certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older and MUST be shown to the Show Secretary before the start of the show.
- 9. The original registration certificate or duplicate application stamped by the ADGA office is required for all animals under six months of age and this MUST be shown to the Show Secretary before the start of the show.
- 10. No copies of the registration certificate or the stamped duplicate application, telegrams, or phone calls will be accepted in lieu of the original certificate.
- 11. A health certificate must be shown to the show officials at the time of unloading. Interstate health papers are required for all animals coming from outside MD. Required for all MD shows** A "Livestock Exhibitor's Self

Certification of Animal Health" must be filled out by the owner/caretaker prior to loading and must be presented upon request to the designated Festival/show official or MDA Animal Health Official. This form can be found either on the reverse side of the 2020 MDA Certificate of Veterinary Inspection or at the MDA website www.mda.state.md.us Any animal showing signs of infectious or contagious disease, as determined by the show officials and/or health check-in official, will be barred from the show. Tattoos may be checked. The decisions of the show officials are final. MD Intrastate Health certificate required of all in state herds.

- 12. Animals must be in place and checked in by 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, check-in will be open no later than 7:00 a.m. and will be released at the conclusion of the show.
- 13. Judging will begin promptly at 8:30 a.m. Breeds will be assigned to each ring and the judges will rotate rings while the breeds are show in the same rings.
- 14. Breed Ring Assignments. We are planning to have both show rings in the main show ring this year. Secretary tables will be located outside of each show ring. Please bring your show books to rings that you will be showing in.

Ring 1 Nigerian Dwarf, Saanen, Recorded Grade, and LaMancha (Back Drop Show ring)	Ring 2 Alpine, Oberhasli, AOP and Nubian (Front Show Ring)
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- 15. This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and their rules shall govern. Only American Dairy Goat Association, American Goat Society, and Canadian Goat Society registered, recorded, or applied for animals may be shown in an official American Dairy Goat Association show.
- 16. MDGA, ADGA, and the Howard County Fairgrounds will not be responsible for loss, damage, or accident to any person, animal or property. Show entry indicates acceptance of this condition.

Youth Show: Again this year we will hold a sanctioned youth show on Sunday, June 28. We will have showmanship competition, a youth show, and Premiere Exhibitor Awards. See separate flyer for complete youth show information.

- 17. Show order is subject to change subject to emergency as determined by the show committee.
- 18. We anticipate a food vendor will be available. Check for updates on the MDGA Facebook page. You may want to be prepared to provide your own meals and beverages. We will be holding a raffle during the show.
- 19. Camping is available for Saturday night for those staying for the Youth Show.

Directions: Howard Co. Fairgrounds are located very close to the intersection of I-70 and Rt. 32. From I-70, take Rt. 32 south ½ mile, turn R on Rt. 144. Take Fairgrounds Rd. on the right. I-70 is the easiest route to take if coming from the North, East, or West. If coming from the South, I-95 to Rt. 32 is probably the quickest route to take.
